Please Read Carefully

* All Spax dampers have the part number stamped into the body of the shock - opposite the ride adjuster for shocks and on the neck of struts and inserts - you may have to clean up or remove road dirt / paint / hammerite / waxoil etc to find it but both the part number and our build code will be physically stamped into the metal, we need these details to accurately supply replacement parts or provide a quote to service or rebuild your dampers.

Please note that we are often unable to supply parts for heritage dampers (those made prior to 1999) as we have improved and developed the design and now use different swaged loops and bushes, however we are proud to have detailed records of every damper made since Spax began and we can manufacture modern, adjustable, upgraded, dimensionally correct replacement dampers to swap out with your existing Spax and enable you to keep your car on the road for many more years to come!
